

Starting right. Scaling smart... AppSense Professional Services



The AppSense Certified Professional (ACP) accreditation measures the ability to configure and administer the AppSense suite of software - AppSense Management Centre, AppSense Environment Manager, AppSense Application Manager and AppSense Performance Manager. It is aimed at customers who will manage the AppSense VUI, and at consultants who will be working with the VUI.

This certification demonstrates your competency in the four components of the AppSense Management Suite; Application Manager, Environment Manager, Performance Manager and Management Centre. It increases your importance to your employer in AppSense users and in Certified Solution Partners, and acts as a measure of your skill in AppSense environments. To achieve this qualification, you will need to pass the AppSense Certified Professional exam code APP-100.

- Recommended pre-requisite knowledge: The AppSense Certified Professional exam is not intended to be easy. It is intended to ensure that you have the level of skill required to implement and administer the AppSense Management Suite. It is recommended that prior to taking this exam you take the three day AppSense Professional level training course, have a good understanding of the AppSense installation documentation available with the products and have experience of working with the AppSense Management Suite.
- The exam consists of 55 questions to be completed in 65 minutes. These questions are multiple choice or drag and drop.
- The exam questions are based around understanding the functionality of the AppSense Management Suite, and installing, licensing and configuring the four components.

The training course which supports this certification is now available from AppSense training partners and the examination is available through our examination partner, Pearson VUE.

The AppSense Certified Specialist (ACS) accreditation demonstrates the ability to perform complex implementations and configurations of the AppSense VUI. It is aimed at specialist consultants who will work with the AppSense Environment Manager, and will form part of the requirements for the AppSense CSP program going forward. In order to achieve the AppSense Certified Specialist accreditation, the candidate will need to have achieved the ACP accreditation, sat the supporting training course and passed the Specialist examination. The Specialist training is due to be released in Q2 2011, with the examination being released shortly after.

The AppSense Certified Expert (ACE) accreditation is the highest level of certification available. It is through invitation only, and candidates will need to have achieved the ACS accreditation to be considered. This certification will be based around direct mentoring of the candidate, and by presentation to a certification board. This level of certification is due for release in Q2 2011.

Scheduling an exam. Before scheduling an AppSense examination, please review the AppSense NDA and Certification Terms. You will be required to accept the NDA (Confidentiality Agreement) immediately prior to commencing your examination; if you do not do so you will not be permitted to take the examination and you will not be issued with a refund.
